

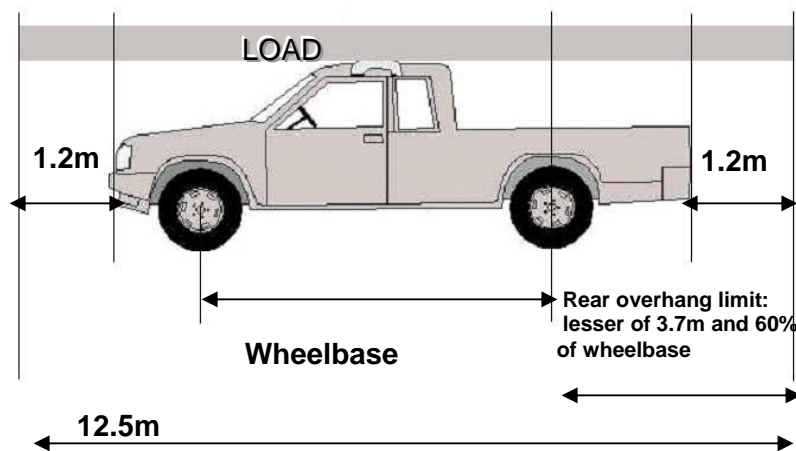

## Size and projection of loads on vehicles

The driver's vision must not be obstructed. Projections/overhangs that are dangerous are not acceptable, even if they are within the limits below.

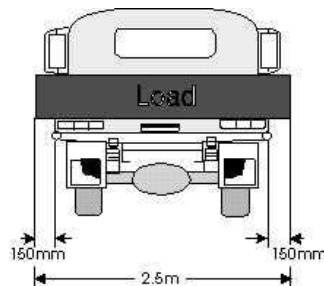
### Vehicle front and rear projection and rear overhang limit



#### Note:

- A maximum rear projection of 1.2m is allowed provided the rear overhang and overall length limits are not exceeded.
- A maximum front projection of 1.2m is allowed provided the overall length limit is not exceeded.
- If your vehicle is built to the maximum allowable dimensions, you cannot carry any projecting load.
- When a rear projection cannot be readily seen from behind then in day time a brightly coloured flag is required or when travelling at night time a red light visible from 200 metres is required.

### Width and side projection limit



**Note:** If your vehicle is built to 2.5m wide, you cannot carry any side projection.
